'YOU'RE HISTORY!'




Drawing a parallel between hierarchical history and the modern schoolyard, *You're History!* is a rollicking musical that will have actors totally rapt and their audience in stitches.





MCHARRYS BUS SERVICES DETOURS

We have been informed by McHarrys that the S22 and S27 school bus services from Charlemont and Ashbury Estate will be on detour from Monday 19th August until the end of the school year. This is due to the upcoming closure of the intersection of Boundary Road and Horseshoe Bend Road.

The McHarrys website is now showing the detour routes that will apply. To search please use the following link: School Bus - Mcharrys Buslines and type S22 and S27 as the destination code. The PDF timetables will show the changes.

It is important to note that:

- Charlemont will ONLY BE SERVICED BY S27 am and pm.
- Ashbury Estate will ONLY BE SERVICED BY S22 am and pm.

The detour options are very limited and it's not possible for McHarrys to easily operate buses in this area.

There are other upcoming works that may impact these detour routes and McHarrys will inform the school of any other changes required as they arise.

NIMENRIX (Meningococcal ACWY)

An important note for parents/guardians - who have already returned completed consent for your son/daughter to receive this vaccination do not need to complete this again.

For those who have not completed consent - updated permission forms have been sent electronically to all Year 10 Parents/Guardians. For those who prefer, some hard copy permission forms are available from the Oberon High School Office upon request and forms can also be emailed to parents.

Parents/Guardians are asked to return completed permission forms via email to Barwon Health Immunisation even if you have ticked no and do not wish for your student to receive the vaccination at school.

What is meningococcal disease?

Meningococcal disease occurs when meningococcal bacteria, commonly found in the nose or throat, invades the body and causes serious disease.

Older teenagers and young adults are most kely to carry the bacteria and spread it to others. here are a number of different types of seningococcal bacteria. Worldwide, the main ypes which cause meningococcal disease are

symptoms of meningococcal disease include tever neadache, vomiting, stiff neck or sore muscles, cometimes followed by a red or purple rash.

he disease can cause complications including ermanent disabilities through loss of limbs, eafness and blindness, scarring and kidney r liver failure.

Five to ten per cent of patients with meningococo disease die, sometimes even with early treatment

Why get vaccinated?

Meningococcal disease is rare but very serious and can quickly become life-threatening. The meningococal ACWY vaccine provides protection against four types of meningococcal disease, including two types which have become more common in Australia in recently ears, caused by the type W and Y bacteria.

There is a separate vaccine that provides protection against meningococcal B type. Speak to your GP or other immunisation provid for more information about this vaccine.

meningococcal vaccine

If an eligible person received a dose of meningococcal C vacche in childhood, it is still recommended to receive the meningococcal ACWY vaccine in adolescence. The meningococcal ACWY vaccine provides protection against A.W.Y types and in addition will boost immunity analyst the C.W.



How do you get vaccinated?

The vaccine is free for all students in year 0 aged 14–6 years through school-based immunisation programs. Even if your child is aged 54–16, they won't receive the vaccine at school if they are not in the eligible year level. Students in the eligible year level will receive a consent form from their school. This consent form must be signed by a parent or guardian and returned to the school before a vaccination is provided.

How can I find out if my child is immunised?

The Australian Immunisation Register keeps a record of vaccinations given in Australia. Persents or guardines of children under 14 years of age can access their childrs immunisation history statement at any time by using your Medicare online account through myGov (mygov.au). Adolescents aged 14 years or older can view their own immunisation history statement, or you own immunisation history statement, or you Department of Human Services permission to
